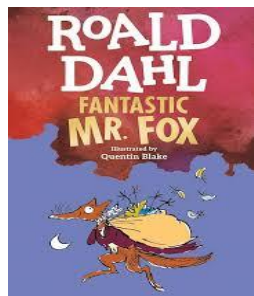

Maths

In maths we will be learning a range of fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills taking the following topics;

- Place Values
- Tens & Ones
- Different representations of number
- Addition & Subtraction

Science

Animals and their Needs
Living things, naming and grouping animals, describing animals and how plants and animals obtain food, offspring, caring for animal babies, caring for pets.



In English I am learning to...

- Write phrases and sentences that make sense to the reader.
- Show awareness of the use of capital letters and full stops for punctuation.
- Segment sounds in words, including long vowels, and blend together when writing.
- Segment spoken words into phonemes and represent these by graphemes, spelling some words correctly and making phonically plausible attempts at others.
- Spell words containing the phonemes taught.
