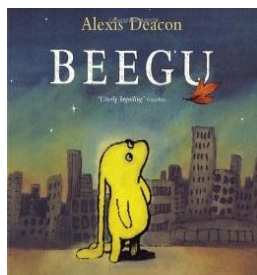
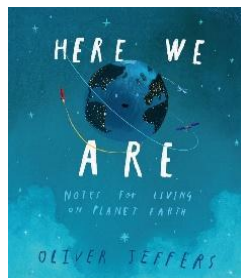

- Use finger spaces to separate words
- Use coordination to extend a sentence using 'and'
