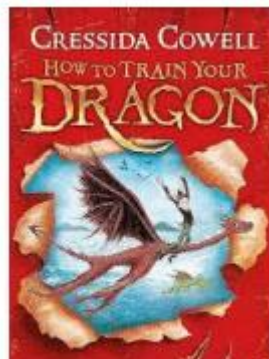


Year 4 – Learning News

Maths

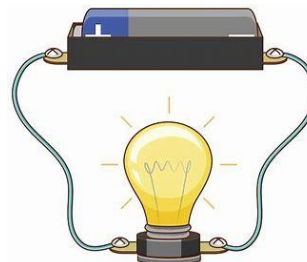
In maths we will be learning a range of fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills taking the following topics;
