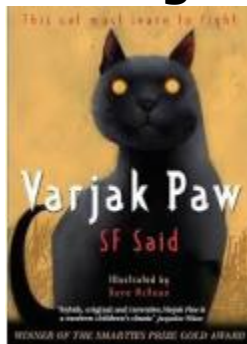
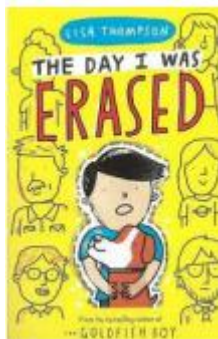


# Year 4 – Learning News
