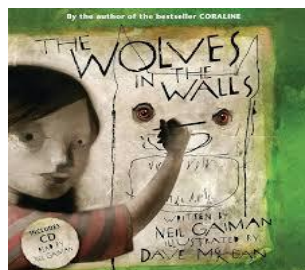
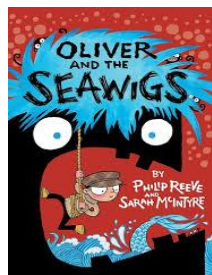

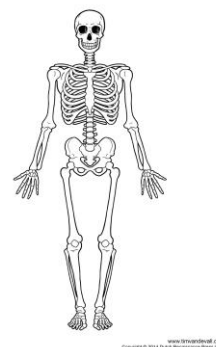
In English I am learning to...

In this unit the pupils will learn about the changing political context of Rome, beginning by being governed by an absolute monarchy, to later the Republic and finally the Empire. Pupils will build on their substantive knowledge of the concepts of government and democracy, and, during this unit, will analyse how Rome was ruled compared with other Unit Rationale ancient and modern civilisations, and how the role of democracy varied during the Roman Empire compared to Britain today.
