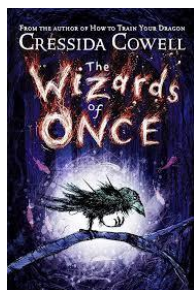
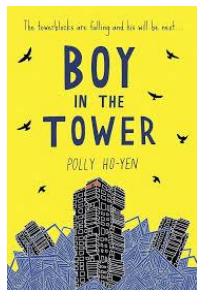


# Year 5 – Learning News
