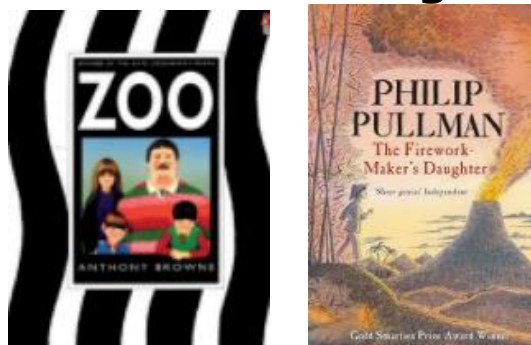

Maths

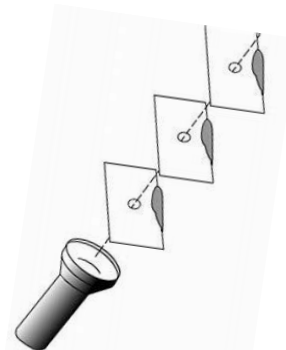
In maths we will be learning a range of fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills taking the following topics;

In English I am learning to...
