Literacy

Demonstrate understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary.

Write short sentences with words with known sound- letter correspondences, using a capital letter and full stops.

Communication and Language

Rhyming and alliteration.
Developing vocabulary
Tell me a story - retelling stories.
Listening and responding to stories
Following instructions
Taking part in discussions
Beginning to answer questions.

Expressive Art & Design

Exploring paint and painting techniques through nature, music and collaborative work linking with festivals and celebrations.

Developing creativity through child-led exploration of mixed-media, making collages and transient art.

Physical Development

Ball skills- throwing and catching. Climbing – apparatus, Exploring a range of wheeled resources for children to balance, sit or ride on, or pull and push.
Threading, cutting, weaving, playdough, Fine Motor activities. Develop muscle tone to put pencil pressure on paper Use tools to effect changes to materials Show preference for dominant hand.

Maths

Pupils will consolidate their counting skills, counting to larger numbers and developing a wider range of counting strategies.

Solve real world mathematical problems with numbers up to 20. Begin to describe a sequence of events, real or fictional, using words such as 'first', 'then...'

Science - Experiment with and talk about, floating and sinking, making boats Investigation.

Geography - Locate different holiday locations on the UK map and world map Weather descriptions (little boat) become a weather reporter Know the dangers of the sun and water and how to stay safe in each.
