Literacy

- talk about what they are going to write about
- to orally rehearse their own words and sentences
- write for different purposes, including captions, lists, speech bubbles and information
- write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others

Communication and Language

Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.

Use picture cue cards to talk about an object: "What colour is it? Where would you find it?"

Sustained focus when listening to a story.
Describe an event in detail.

Expressive Art & Design

Environmental art. Look at work of Walter Mason, describe what they see and give an opinion about his work.

Explore with his techniques e.g. lines, circles, spirals using natural objects.
Collect and name natural objects from our local environment.

Physical Development

Ball skills- throwing and catching. Climbing – apparatus, Exploring a range of wheeled resources for children to balance, sit or ride on, or pull and push.
Threading, cutting, weaving, playdough, Fine Motor activities. Develop muscle tone to put pencil pressure on paper Use tools to effect changes to materials Show preference for dominant hand.

Maths

Pupils will consolidate their counting skills, counting to larger numbers and developing a wider range of counting strategies. They will secure knowledge of number facts through varied practice.
