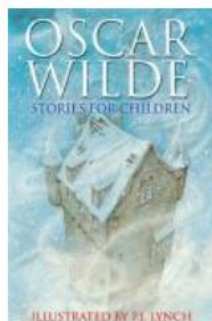

We are reading....



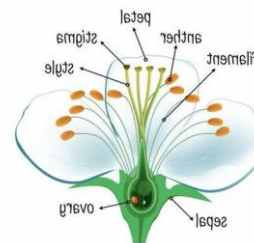
Maths

In maths we will be learning a range of fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills taking the following topics;

- Time
- Fractions
- Properties of Shape
- Mass & Capacity

Science

Plants Functions of plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers, Life and growth, variety of plants, water transportation, seed formation and dispersal.



In English I am learning to... Write effectively and coherently for different purposes, drawing on their reading to inform the vocabulary and grammar of their writing.

- Make use of paragraphing and organisational devices to structure writing.
- Use co-ordination and subordination to extend sentences (eg when, if, because, although).
- Make simple additions, revisions and proof-reading corrections to their own writing.
- Use the punctuation taught at key stage 1 correctly.
- Spell most common exception words from the Year 2 list and some from the Year 3/4 list.
